He has served as the Chief of Dairy Laboratories, Chief of Dairy Inspection, and became Director of the Division of Dairy Industry. In 2012 The Divisions of Dairy Industry and Food Safety were merged together and he now serves as the Chief of the Bureau of Dairy Industry. Mr. Miller has been active with the Dairy Division of the National Association of State Departments of Agriculture (now National Association of Dairy Regulatory Officials) and served as president 2003-2004. Mr. Miller attended his first NCIMS Conference in 1993. Since then has served on the Laboratory Committee, International Certification Program Committee, Council III and the Executive Board. During his spare time he enjoys his family, friends and back roads in his little Sky sports car.
