I encourage your thoughtful and active participation in this 30th session of the NCIMS!

Mrs. Bordson is proud of her rural heritage growing up and sharing chores on a family farm in central Illinois. She received her B.S. in Education from Illinois State University and has been employed by the Illinois Department of Public Health, Division of Food, Drugs and Dairies, for 32 years in a variety of positions in food and dairy sanitation. She recently was appointed Division Chief, having served as Dairy Program Manager for 14 years. Earlier, she served as Regional Supervisor for the Division in the Champaign Regional Office. Mrs. Bordson currently serves on the Illinois Department of Professional Regulation Board of Environmental Health Practitioners, the Illinois Department of Agriculture Johnes Disease Advisory Committee and is an advisory member of both the Illinois Milk Producers Association Board and the Associated Illinois Milk, Food and Environmental Sanitarians Board.
