CONFERENCE CHAIR

It is once again my great privilege to welcome you to the 36th National Conference on Interstate Milk Shipments (NCIMS), held this year in Grand Rapids, Michigan. The cooperative program of NCIMS involving all 50 states, the U.S. Trust Territory of Puerto Rico, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA), and members of both industry and academia has been effective at protecting public health for over 60 years, and continues to serve as a critical forum for ensuring that standards and practices published in the Pasteurized Milk Ordinance (PMO) represent the most current scientific knowledge and technical expertise in the safety of Grade-A milk and milk products. NCIMS remains in an ideal position to leverage its highly effective national Grade-A milk safety program, and its collective specialized dairy expertise, as a critical partner with FDA in the implementation of the Food Safety Modernization Act and associated Federal Rules. Significant strides were made at the 2015 Conference in bringing the PMO in alignment with requirements of the Preventive Controls for Human Food Rule, and important final revisions to complete that alignment will be deliberated by state agencies, FDA and the regulated industry at this year's Conference. NCIMS has an outstanding record of success in bringing together diverse stakeholders to discuss complex matters related to the ongoing science-based improvement of regulatory food safety oversight for Grade-A milk products, and the 2017 Conference will undoubtedly continue in that valued tradition as 98 proposals for revising the PMO or other NCIMS documents will be considered by state delegates.

As always, the success of the unique forum that NCIMS provides depends upon the active participation by Conference attendees. Thus, I once again encourage you as a Conference registrant to engage with your colleagues, to attend committee meetings, ask questions, and contribute to discussions on key issues raised in the many proposals submitted for consideration. By doing so, we will all ensure that the 2017 Conference will be as successful as ever in advancing the mission of NCIMS to "Assure the safest possible milk supply for all the people."

Stephen Beam, Ph.D., 2017 Conference Chair California Department of Food and Agriculture

Dr. Beam earned his B.S. and M.S. degrees in Animal Science from the University of Nevada-Reno, and his Ph.D. in Physiology of Reproduction, Field of Animal Science from Cornell University, with minors in both Cellular Physiology and Nutritional Metabolism, conducting research primarily in dairy cattle. This was followed by a 3-year postdoctoral fellowship in the Department of Animal Science at UC-Davis. Dr. Beam has been with the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) since 1999, serving in both the Division of Inspection Services and the Division of Animal Health and Food Safety Services. In addition to being a certified Registered Dairy Inspector with CDFA, he has served as the Supervisor of the Commercial Feed and Livestock Drug Inspection Program, and was appointed as Chief of the Milk and Dairy Food Safety Branch of CDFA in 2004, where he continues to manage all aspects of the statewide inspection program for milk and milk products in California. Dr. Beam attended his first NCIMS Conference in 2005, and since then has served on several NCIMS committees. He was elected to the NCIMS Executive Board in 2009, and has served as Chair of the Executive Board since April 2013.
