## A. Summary of Proposal

To align the requirement for verifying the accuracy of farm bulk milk tanks to six (6) months in Item 18r with Appendix B item 3.c. in the 2019 PMO.

## B. Reason for the Submission and Public Health Significance and/or Rationale Supporting the Submission

2019 PMO, Section 7, Item 18r Administrative Procedure 3.b. (page 60) specifies that a farm bulk milk tank's, "temperature recording device shall be verified every six (6) months and documented in a manner acceptable to the Regulatory Agency..." Appendix B, Section I, Evaluation of Bulk Milk Hauler/Sampler Procedures, Item 3.c. (page 140) currently specifies, "Accuracy of required recording thermometers shall be checked monthly against a standardized thermometer and recorded." This proposal aligns the verification of farm bulk milk tank recording thermometers in Appendix B with the six (6) month minimum frequency established in Section 7, Item 18r.
